COACHES AND TRAINERS



Charles "Chuck" Johnson Head Coach

Coach Johnson has been at Ridgewood High School in Ridgewood, NJ since 1984. This year marks his 35th season with the Ridgewood Maroons Football team and 41 years overall

as a Head Coach. He has compiled a 233-115-1 record in Ridgewood. His teams have won four State Sectional Championships and ten Division Championships. His overall football record, which includes his years coaching at Bogota High School in Bogota, NJ 260-123-1.

Coach Johnson graduated from Ridgewood High School in 1970 and earned his BA degree from Gettysburg College where he lettered in both football and baseball. Coach Johnson obtained a masters equivalency from Montclair State University and teaches Wellness, Lifestyle, Stress Management and Strength and Conditioning at Ridgewood High School.

Chuck is married to Sara Holmes Johnson, also a 1970 graduate of Ridgewood High School. Coach Johnson's children attended the Ridgewood school systems. He is currently a Wellness teacher at Ridgewood High School.



Mark Aramburu Linebackers/Offensive Line

Coach Aramburu is back coaching Ridgewood football. He graduated from Frontier Central High School in Hamburg, NY in 1980 and attended Ithaca College where he played

Linebacker, he graduated with a degree in Health and Physical Education in 1984. He later attended Syracuse University and graduated with his M.S. in 1986. In addition to coaching at Ridgewood, Coach Aramburu also coached at a number of other high schools and has been coaching for over 26 years. He is a Health and Physical Education teacher.




Nik Nicholaides, MS, ATC, CSCS Certified Athletic Trainer



Class of 2014 Jamal Locke #1 Yale University


